A daytime group support program for women who are immigrants/refugees in Canada. Participants should have an intermediate level of English.

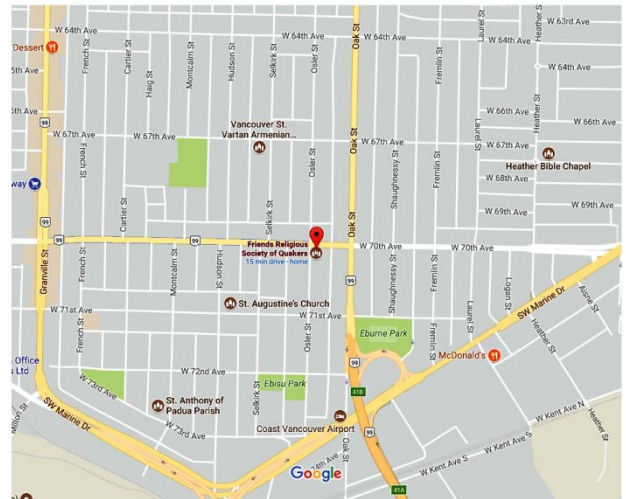
LEAD is a professionally facilitated program for immigrant women to:
