You will:

- Learn skills to be a Kitchen helper or Hotel housekeeping room attendant
- Develop kitchen awareness, and use kitchen knives and other equipment safely
- Prepare basic food and learn cooking skills
- Learn job search skills
- Take WorldHost® and FOODSAFE™ Level 1
- Have a 2-week workplace practicum and gain Canadian work experience
- Receive a VCC Entry to Hospitality Careers for Women Award of Achievement

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

You may be eligible if you are:

- Unemployed and non EI eligible, no EI claims in the past three years and no maternity/paternity EI claims in the past five years
- Underemployed
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or protected person legally entitled to work in Canada
- Living in British Columbia
- Not a student (i.e. not enrolled in high school or enrolled in post-secondary training)
- Experiencing difficulties securing employment due to lack of skills or training

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have:

- English (CLB level 4 or above in Speaking and Listening, CLB 2 or above in Reading and Writing)
- Able to commit to a part-time program (10:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.) for 12 weeks
- Physically fit to work in a kitchen environment (e.g. no food or chemical allergies)
