- ❖ Be encouraged to take a more active role in the community

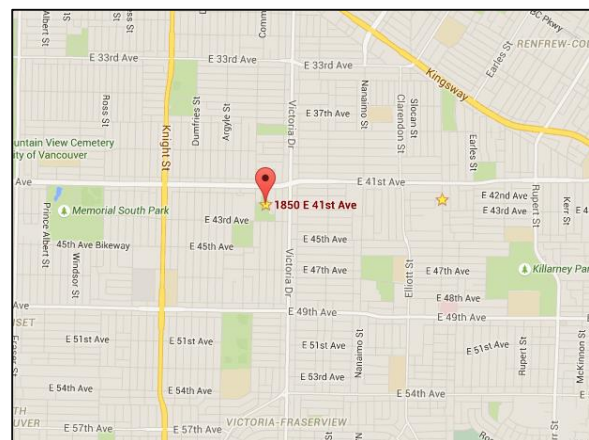
Group discussions focus on settlement, cultural adjustment and personal development.

*Free childcare is available for children 18 months to 5 years old, while their mothers attend class. In the early childhood education (ECE) program, children learn through play, songs and stories as they prepare for Canadian life and get ready for school entry.*
