



## Part time Early Childhood Educator

To work with new immigrant and refugee children. Be willing to work in different locations (Vancouver, Burnaby, New Westminister, Surrey) in a regular part-time position and /or as an on-call sub.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepare the setting before the children arrive and secure everything before you leave.
- Participate in the planning and implementation of quality, age appropriate program for the young children of women attending the PIRS Program.
- Ensure the safety of the children in the program.
- Create an environment that fosters positive self-concept and reflects the cultural diversity of the children.
- Participate in the planning of activities which will support and encourage English language learning while valuing and maintaining the first language.
- Welcome and become acquainted with parents and orient them to the programs
- Inform guide and support other program staff or volunteers as required.
- Attend and participate in program team meetings and participate in Children's program staff workshops and meetings.

### DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Valid Early Childhood Education Certificate, BC ECE or BC ECE Assistant License.
- Considerable experience working with children 18 months to 5 years of age.
- Valid First aid Certificate.
- Current Criminal Record Certificate.
- An interest (and preferably experience) in working within a multi-ethnic community.
- Demonstrated ability to work in the team environment and willingness to work with volunteers and other children's staff.
- Attitudes and values in keeping with goals and philosophy of PIRS.
- Additional language would be an asset.
- Experience working with refugee families.
