## Women's Leadership and Development Programs | For immigrant and refugee women with Intermediate level of English

### **Early Childhood Education Assistant Training**

Skill training program for immigrant and refugee women to become skilled and certified ECE Assistants. Includes 12 weeks of classroom learning and four weeks of on-the job experience with a local employer.

Eligibility: Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or protected persons, entitled to work in Canada; at least 18 years old and have SIN; living in BC; unemployed or precariously employed; CLB 6 English or above; able to pass Criminal Record Check, including vulnerable sector check.

#### **Pathways to Childcare Careers**
